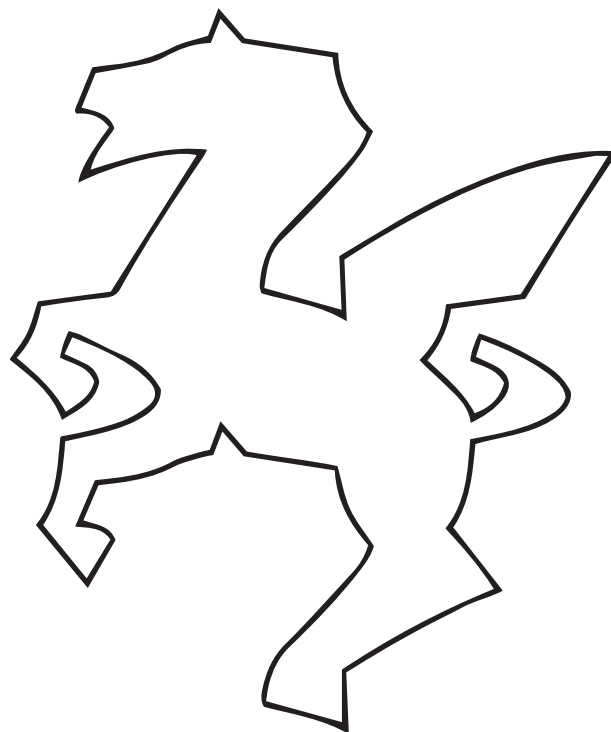

Tessellations

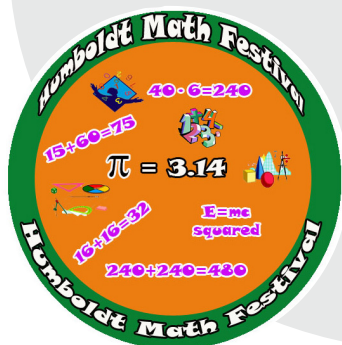
